We are so pleased to welcome you to Tots 'n' Toys.

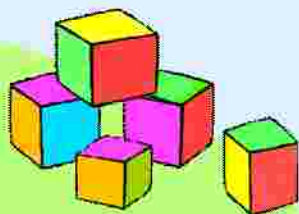
Tots 'n' Toys was started over twenty years ago by members of Thornhill Church. They wanted to create a safe and happy place for their children to play and socialise, to provide a welcoming place for all parents and carers to enjoy each other's company, and to make a positive contribution to the life of our community. Twenty years on our aims are still the same!

Members of the team are all volunteers and most are members of Thornhill Church. Underpinning our aims is our belief that people matter to God and all are loved by Him.


During the session we provide:

- a baby play area with suitable toys
- ride ons and toys for older toddlers
- Playdough or a craft activity for you to do with your child
- Singing time - a really important part of our session. Please encourage your child to take part and do join in yourself. It is so helpful for little ones to see the adults singing. Honestly! Please let us know if it is your child's birthday too.
- Squash/water and biscuits for the children. Tea and coffee for the adults

We like to celebrate with parties and events at Christmas and Easter and organise a Summer trip. We also run Parenting Courses and organise social events for the adults at various times.



While we want everyone to have great fun at Tots we also want to ensure everyone keeps safe, so we ask that you take very careful note of the following points:-

- When you attend for the first time we will ask you to complete a registration form. Its important that we know who is attending. This information may also be used to contact you with Tots 'n' Toys news. All information is treated in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998.
- We keep a register of who attends each week. This is for fire safety reasons so please ensure you register as soon as you arrive each week.
- You are responsible for the children you bring at all times. This includes the way they interact with others, so if they are about to clobber someone...please intervene!
- If the fire alarm sounds you must take your child/children immediately through one of the fire exits and gather on the grass area outside the church building where we need to take a register.
- Take care when using the main door and make sure the top latch is secured whenever you enter or leave the hall.
- We serve hot drinks at Tots which everyone enjoys, but obviously extra care is required with so many little ones around. Please try not to walk around with your drink, use the cup lids provided and NEVER leave your drink unattended.
- The stage area and kitchen are out of bounds.
- The toilets are through the coffee shop and through the double doors. Baby changing facilities are situated in the disabled toilet. Please use the nappy bags provided.
- Please inform a member of the team if your child has an accident.
