Thornhill Church is Evangelical Church in the Thornhill area of North Cardiff. Houses started to be built in this area in 1978 and a few Christians moved here and started a 'church' by meeting in homes here from 1982. They then met in pubs, did tent missions, met in schools and in 1997 around 40 of them prayed and paid for our great church building that has now been serving the community for over 25 years. We are the only church in people and in building in this area of 3157 homes with a population of around 7500 people. A part from that, in Thornhill there's a large Sainsbury's, doctor's surgery, a few pubs, lovely parks and large crematorium. The church is currently made up of around 150 people with diverse ethnicities and backgrounds. We have over 100 people who meet weekly in 12 home groups. We do weekly schools work, toddler groups, kids, youth, seniors groups, have a full time nursery and a midweek café open to the public and support overseas missions, CAP, foodbank, TAVS & Concern Cymru.

It's all about Jesus, because of Jesus and for Jesus. We want to be a church DEVOTED to Jesus, His Church and His Mission.

# Thornhill Church Cardiff Part Time Childrens Worker

### To be employed/salaried 20 hrs a week, with hopeful start - January 2023. Salary can be requested with CV application or email of interest.

WE NEED HELP!!! Our children's work at church has grown with many great opportunities and our church members are serving as much as they can. So we need to employ someone to oversee, lead, equip and encourage children and church volunteers to all grow in Jesus. Below are examples of what we are currently doing and what we need help with, but nothing is set in stone, so we are open to ideas, thoughts and changes that someone new will bring.....

#### Sunday Morning Service - 10:30am - 12pm.

During our service around 11am, 4 different groups go out for age specific time with Tots Time (0-4s), Junior Church 1 (infants) Junior Church 2 (juniors) and No Limits (11-14s). You would oversee Junior Church 1 + 2 and work with church volunteers serving on the rota, plan and share materials, and be involved with the children to encourage their faith and give them opportunity to grow and explore their Father God. #### Kids Club – Mondays 3:30pm – 5pm

As parents and church volunteers we've been running a weekly community Kids Club every Monday for primary school children during term time 3:30pm - 5pm. It is NOT a drop off club so parents chat together or sit in our café to wait. We can get up to 30 kids but we need someone to lead the group, update one another, sort the admin and give Biblical feeding to the kids each week, as well as them all having lots of fun in the free time. #### School Work - Wednesdays 9:15am - 9:45am

Our Pastor currently goes into Thornhill Primary School to do year group assemblies – 60 pupils each time. He wants to hand over to a Kids Worker as we have a great relationship with the school and when we employ someone the opportunity could be that we can increase this to do weekly assemblies for the whole school, so 450 pupils each week! It's a great way to sow seeds for Jesus.

#### <u>Tots n Toys – Wednesdays 10am – 11:30am</u>

For pre-school children we have our nursery, a small support group for first time mums and a popular toddler group that's been serving the community for over 20 years. Like other ministries we have great church members volunteering in these groups but Tots n Toys toddler group will be a good place for the children's worker to join the team, take a leading role when need be and share Jesus.

#### Pastoral

You would be the pastoral contact for 0-11 year olds and their parents in Church. As a Church Trust we employ 15 people with most of them being Christians in Thornhill Church as we have pastoral church staff, Nursery staff, Café and Building staff and everything is for Jesus with the desire for us to serve Him and others to know Him. You would join this team, so check our website for more details.

#### <u>Other</u>

We appreciate this role is part time and the applicant will take holidays, but when possible we would like them to run school holiday clubs, and to pop into our nursery, 1<sup>st</sup> time mums + other church ministries with the desire to build relationships and to see if there are openings for things like daytime alpha, parenting courses, messy church, etc. We want to give space for the Spirit to shape this role.

#### <u>Role</u>

We would envisage you to work 1 or 2 late afternoon/evenings a week. Sunday morning meetings are required in this role/hours, but other days/hours are flexible if you have other work, commitments and if church parents, school, etc can work with it. Out of the 20 hours we would envisage 10 hours face to face work with children, and 10 hours for prep, etc. We consider working for our church a calling, so the applicant (& their spouse/children if they have) would need to feel called to become fully part of our church.

#### <u>Apply</u>

We can be flexible but we would ideally have the applicant start in Jan 2023. # Thornhill Church Cardiff Part Time Youth Worker

### To be employed/salaried 20 hrs a week, with hopeful start - January 2023. Salary can be requested with CV application or email of interest.

Our current youth work in our church is small, but we want to invest in the young people and families we have with the desire to reach the hundreds of teenagers and families in our area with the Gospel. So we'd like to employ someone to grow, create new opportunities, oversee, lead, equip and encourage our 11-18 year olds, their families and church volunteers to all grow in Jesus. Below are examples of what we are currently doing and our desires, but nothing is set in stone so we are open to ideas, thoughts and changes.....

#### Sunday Morning Service - No Limits

- Providing spiritual input when our 11-14 go out for their own time during our Sunday services.
- Overseeing + equipping the team of volunteers, getting more when need be, providing material, etc.
- Being on the rota most/every week or making sure you have cover so you can have time in the service.

#### Sun Night Youth

- Providing spiritual input for 14-18 currently on Sunday Evenings.
- Overseeing + equipping the team of volunteers, getting more when need be, providing material, etc.
  - Being there every week.

#### School Work

- To try and get into in the local high school Llanishen High on a weekly basis either through assembly, drop in or CU?
  - To possibly try and connect/do something with year 6 pupils in Thornhill Primary before they enter secondary.
    - To meet with other church youth workers for support, ideas and partnership in school, etc.

#### Pastoral

- To pastorally look after and be the contact for 11-18 year olds and parents in the church.
- To meet with or speak to the church pastor/elders when need be for help or advice.
  - To be on safeguarding team at church.

#### Other youth work

- On another evening (or linked with the Sun night youth) we would like you to start a new work for teenagers in the community whether through street work, youth club in our building or one for church 11-18 year olds to bring friends.
- To look at creative ways to engage + connect with non-Christian young people in bringing them to faith and the church.
  To mentor young people in the church and equip others in church to mentor young people.

#### <u>Other</u>

- We would expect you to take youth to at least one summer mission or conference each year.
- We would expect you to run/take youth to at least one weekend away another time in the year.
- We consider working for our church a calling, so the applicant (& their spouse/children if they have) would need to feel called to become fully part of our church.

#### Hours

- We would envisage you to work 1-2 evenings a week (which includes a Sunday).
- Sunday morning meetings are required as work hours and other days, hours are flexible if you have other commitments.
- Out of the 20 hours we would envisage you to do 10 hours face to face work with young people, and 10 hours for prep, admin, course, meetings, etc.
